Lk 24:27 And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.

Lk 24:44: "This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms."

Pentateuch: Gen., Ex., Lev., Num., & Deut.

Mk 12:26 "...have you not read in the book of Moses, in the passage about the burning bush..."

2Chron 25:4 quotes from "the Law, in the Book of Moses..." Deut 24:16

2Chron 35:12 talks about subdivisions laid out in the Book of Moses. Lev 3:6-16

The entire Pentateuch was called:

the Law of Moses (Ezra 11:6)

the Book of the Law of Moses (Neh 8:1)

the Book of Moses (Neh 13:1)

the Book of the Law of the LORD that had been given through Moses (2Chron 34:14)

the Book of the Covenant (2Chron 34:30)

the Book of the Law (2Kngs 22:8)

1st Messianic prophecy: Gen 3:15 "And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel."

Gen 4:1 Adam lay with his wife Eve, and she became pregnant and gave birth to Cain. She said, "With the help of the LORD I have brought forth a man."

Gen 5:29 "He will comfort us in the labor and painful toil of our hands caused by the ground the LORD has cursed."

Gen 9:26 "Blessed be the LORD, the God of Shem!"

Call of Abraham- Gen 11, 12
